- Previous Business
 - May board meeting minutes approval Motion by Bill C., Second by Andrea. In favor – All.
 - Incredible Lawns update Sod repaired around Observation. Irrigation panel to be moved from 956B.
 - 960B Tower Ct gutter downspout gap was repaired and the ground washout has improved. Jeremy checked after rain and some small area is still washing away. Still cannot determine where the washout is occurring. Will keep an eye on them.
 - ARC request Numbering on MFH (building 1 & 8). Jeremy paid for the letters/numbers. Will pick up number and letters from Jaxson Signs tomorrow. Then install them soon.
 - Financials Financials posted to the website per Bill C request. Bill C only 1 past due now. Bill C got Premier to pay off the insurance loan.

 - Sallie's reminder to ask Tina for contractor list.
 - MFH unit decking needs to be readdressed as the decks need to be rebuilt.
 Sallie offered 3 options to get them rebuilt. 1. Full assessment to cover entire rebuild. 2. Shared assessment and portion of reserve to be used. 3. UNKNOWN.
 Will need get quotes in late summer.
